Relevant Information:

- Camp cost is \$330.00. Money to be paid no later than Thursday, 22nd February.
- Consent form to be returned earlier, no later than Thursday, 15th February.
- Teachers attending camp are Mr Dickinson, Mrs Dickinson, Miss Stanton, Mrs Stagbouer and Mr Cianfrini.
- Water Consent Form used for swimming lessons will be used for Camp, as regards special medication and dietary requirements.
- All programmed activities are conducted by qualified instructors with teachers lending a supporting role.
- Safety of students is paramount on all excursions. You can be assured that all staff involved in this camp are very experienced and meet the requirements laid down by the Department of Education and Training.

SUGGESTED CLOTHING AND CAMP ITEMS

Remember this is only a four day camp, so don't over pack.

- Sleeping bag and /or sheets/blankets and a pillow.
- Adequate clothing for 4 days, including shorts, shirts, jumper, track suit and/or jeans, bathers, underwear. No school uniform.
- Appropriate footwear, must bring sneakers.
